**Community Garden Spending Ordinance** - Mayor Bruning opened the public hearing for the following Ordinance:

**Old Beaver Run Road Reconstruction Award Resolution -** Motion by D'Angeli, seconded by Hughes, to adopt the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that on September 15, 2015 the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette adopted Resolution 2015-46 to award unit bid prices for individual construction items to perform the necessary construction work to complete the Old Beaver Run Road Reconstruction, a New Jersey Department of Transportation Local Aid funded project with a total project grant award in the amount of \$70,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette does hereby award unit prices for individual construction items based unit prices as awarded under the individual contracts awarded by the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council bidding process with a total cost of \$67,641.25. # Audience

<u>Ms. Anne Sellinger</u>, 144 Meadows Road, asked about the progress of the Route 15 & 94 and Sunset Inn Road intersection. Committeeman D'Angeli said our \$6,000 share of the project was being sent to the NJDOT. The project is continuing.

<u>Mr. John Elzinga</u>, Fire Department Chief, reported 14 air bottles are out of date. He said they will be replacing seven (7) of them next year. The bottles cost \$1,200 per bottle; however, they may purchase just the sleeve for \$800 each.

Mr. Elzinga said three (3) members have completed Fire 1 and are in need of equipment.

Mr. Elzinga thanked Committeeman Hughes for his help with the FCC license.

Committeeman Hughes asked if the bottles were on State contract. Mr. Elzinga said they were and parts are listed on the Morris County Cooperative.

<u>Mr. John Strowe</u>, EMS Captain, said two (2) of the members completing Fire 1 are, also, in the EMT class.

<u>Mr. Carl Luthman</u>, 17 Brandywine Court, suggested sidewalks being installed along Route 15 when the bridge is replaced. He said he spoke to our area Legislatures for help. A resolution endorsing the sidewalks would be needed to request a grant. The Township Committee supports this project. Mr. Luthman will submit a resolution for adoption.
