The Annual Organization meeting of the Lafayette Township Committee was held on Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at 7pm. in the Municipal Building, 33 Morris Farm Road, Lafayette, NJ

Committeeman Hughes called the meeting to order stating that it was being held in compliance with the Public Laws of 1975, Chapter 231, Sections 4 & 13.

Members Present: Committeemen Bruning, Corcoran, D'Angeli, Henderson and Hughes

Members Absent None

Also Present: Deputy County Clerk Angela Rosa

Deputy County Clerk Angela Rosa administered the Oath of Office to Committeemen Corcoran and Henderson.

Nominations for Mayor for 2018. Bruning nominated Hughes and Corcoran Hughes seconded the nomination. Further nominations were called for and there being none, Mr. Hughes was declared Mayor for 2018. Deputy County Clerk Angela Rosa administered the Oath of Office to Mayor Hughes.

Mayor Hughes called for nominations for Deputy Mayor. Bruning nominated D'Angeli and Corcoran seconded the nomination. Further nominations were called for and there being none, Mr. D'Angeli was declared Deputy Mayor for 2018. Deputy County Clerk Angela Rosa administered the Oath of Office to Deputy Mayor D'Angeli.

Motion by Bruning, seconded by D'Angeli, to continue holding regular meetings on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 7:30 P.M. in the Lafayette Township Municipal Building, 33 Morris Farm Road, Lafayette, NJ with the exception of the first meetings in June and November which shall be held on the first Wednesday of the month due to elections. Motion carried by roll call vote: Henderson-yes, Corcoran-yes, Bruning-yes, D'Angeli-yes, Hughes-yes.

Motion by Bruning, seconded by Corcoran, to designate the New Jersey Herald and the Sunday Herald as the official newspapers for the Township of Lafayette. Motion carried by roll call vote: Henderson-yes, Corcoran-yes, Bruning-yes, D'Angeli-yes, Hughes-yes.

Motion by Bruning, seconded by Corcoran, to adopt the following Resolution:  
BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette that the Lakeland Bank and New Jersey Cash Management Fund be designated as the depositories for all current funds for the Township and the Custodian shall be CMFO Gail Magura. Mayor Hughes, Gail Magura and Anna Rose Fedish shall sign all checks with the Deputy Mayor to sign in an emergency. Motion carried by roll call vote: Henderson-yes, Corcoran-yes, Bruning-yes, D'Angeli-yes, Hughes-yes.

Motion by Corcoran, seconded by Bruning, to adopt the following Resolution:  
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPUTY MAYOR TO SIGN DOCUMENTS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of Lafayette Township to provide for the orderly administration of Township business to permit the Deputy Mayor to execute any and all legal documents that the Mayor is authorized to execute in the event the Mayor is unable due to vacation, illness or general unavailability;

WHEREAS, in the recent past there have been documents that required execution where the Mayor because of vacations or other scheduling problems has not been available; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Township Committee has resolved that it is in the best interest of the Township to allow the Deputy Mayor to sign all documents in the Mayor's absence so long as the same are attested to by the Township Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette Township Committee as follows: That the Deputy Mayor be permitted to execute and bind the Township on all documents that the Mayor would have otherwise been authorized to execute on the behalf of the Township in the event of the absence of the Mayor and the inability to secure the original signature of the Mayor.

Motion carried by roll call vote: Henderson-yes, Corcoran-yes, Bruning-yes, D'Angeli-yes, Hughes-yes.

Motion by Henderson, seconded by Corcoran, to adopt the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette that the rate of interest to be charged is hereby fixed at 8% per annum for amounts under \$1,500 and 18% per annum for any amount in excess of \$1500; the date of delinquency shall be ten (10) days after the quarterly due date, after which interest shall be charged from the due date of the quarter, and if a delinquency is in excess of \$10,000 and remain in arrears beyond December 31<sup>st</sup>, an additional penalty of 6% shall be charged against the delinquency; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector be and is hereby authorized to collect interest at the rate aforesaid.

Motion carried by roll call vote: Henderson-yes, Corcoran-yes, Bruning-yes, D'Angeli-yes, Hughes-yes.

Motion by Bruning, seconded by Henderson, to adopt the following Resolution appointing professional services:

WHEREAS N.J.S.A. 11-5 Local Public Contract Law permits Governing bodies to contract for certain professional services without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lafayette has need for said professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey that the following appointments be made for the year 2017:
