
MAILBOX STANDARDS

Please repair/maintain your mailbox for the safety of all drivers.

GENERAL NOTES:

- ^ Post must be a minimum of 4"x4" wood or 2" diameter steel pipe
- ^ Faces of mailbox must be between 6"-7" behind the face of curb or edge of pavement
- ^ Height of mailbox must be between 41" and 45" above the road surface
- ^ Post must be embedded securely into the ground at least 24" deep
- ^ Mailbox must be securely fastened to the post
 - *As per USPS Mailbox Guidelines
