- 1. An emergency appropriation is hereby made for Legal-Other Expenses for professional fees associated with the appeal of the 2020-2021 High Point Regional Board of Education Budget in the amount of \$10,000.00.
- 2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in full in the 2021 budget, and is requested to be excluded from CAPS, pursuant to NJS 40A:4-53.3c(1).
- 3. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
