**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF LAFAYETTE FOR THE YEAR 2025**

1. The annual salaries of all officer names hereafter for the year 2025 and for each year thereafter, until amended or repealed are hereby established and fixed at the following sums in lieu of any and all fees and remuneration to which the respective incumbents of said office might otherwise be entitled, except, however, that which may be authorized by resolution of the Township Committee, to wit:
