RESOLUTION 2021-42

**RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE TO
AUTHORIZE THE TAX COLLECTOR TO CANCEL 50% OF THE 2021 TAXES
ACCRUING AFTER JANUARY 26, 2021 AND ISSUE A REFUND TO
MARION J FRITSCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,421.42 DUE TO THE
APPROVAL BY THE TAX ASSESSOR OF A PARTIAL
TAX EXEMPTION FOR BLOCK 25, LOT 3.03**

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration had assigned a 100% Disabled Veteran rating to Robert Fritsch, deceased, formerly of Stillwater Township; and

WHEREAS, an application for a 100% Exempt Veteran was made to the Tax Assessor on January 26, 2021, by Marion J Fritsch, widow of Robert Fritsch, who is 50% owner of 44 Fox Hill Road, known as Block 25, Lot 3.03; and the Tax Assessor approved the application as of that date, which makes Mrs. Fritsch exempt from paying property taxes after January 26, 2021; and

WHEREAS, taxes were due and paid in the amount of \$11,883.38 for the first three quarters of year 2021, and based on the date of application the amount due for the 1st thru 3rd quarter of 2021 is \$6,461.96, creating an overpayment in the amount of \$5,421.42.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette, Sussex County, New Jersey, that Daryn Cashin, the Tax Collector, be authorized to cancel 50% the taxes accruing after January 26, 2021, and refund Marion J. Fritsch the overpaid amount of \$5,421.42.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Tax Collector, the Chief Financial Officer, and Township Auditor for their records.
