RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE TO
ISSUE A TAX REFUND TO US BANK CUST FOR PRO CAP 8
IN REGARDS TO THE REDEMPTION OF TAX SALE
CERTIFICATE # 2019-001 SOLD FOR DELINQUENT TAXES FOR
BLOCK 8, LOT 2, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,515.96

WHEREAS, On October 7, 2019, tax sale certificate #2019-001 was sold for delinquent 2018 taxes on Block 8, Lot 2, owners of record 99 Route 15 LLC, to US Bank Cust for Pro Cap 8 in the amount of \$4,348.00; and

WHEREAS, the lienholder, US Bank Cust for Pro Cap 8, paid a premium of \$3,900.00 at the time of sale, and subsequent 2019 to 2021 taxes in the amount of \$10,651.61; and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2021, Tamara Didyk and William Rogers, representing 99 Route 15, LLC, paid the lien and subsequent principal of \$14,999.61, redemption penalty in the amount of \$86.96, recording and search fees in the amount of \$62.00, and interest in the amount of \$2,467.39 through October 20, 2021 for the redemption of Tax Sale Certificate #2019-001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of Lafayette, Sussex County, New Jersey, that upon certification of Daryn L. Cashin, Tax Collector, a refund be issued to US Bank Cust for Pro Cap 8 in the amount of \$21,515.96.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Tax Collector, the Chief Financial Officer, and Township Auditor for their records.
