**GOVERNOR’S COUNCIL ON SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
FISCAL GRANT CYCLE OCTOBER 2020-JUNE 2026**

WHEREAS, the Governor’s Council on Substance Use Disorder (GCSUD) established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Substance Use Disorder in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent substance use disorder in communities throughout New Jersey; and

WHEREAS , the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey recognizes that substance use disorder is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and therefore, has as established Municipal Alliance Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent substance use disorder in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has applied for funding to the Governor’s Council on Substance Use Disorder through the County of Sussex.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Lafayette, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey hereby recognizes the following:
